TOURNAMENT FORMAT: The 2014 New Zealand Open will be conducted over four days on Thursday 27 February,

Friday 28 February, Saturday 1 March and Sunday 2 March

Within the NZ Open will be the NZ Open Pro Am

New Zealand Open

The NZ Open field will comprise of 136 players

Scoring for the NZ Open will be stroke play Players to compete off **BLACK TEES**

The leading 60 professionals and ties plus any amateur in that score or better, will qualify for the final two rounds on Saturday and Sunday.

Rounds 1 and 2 will be played over The Hills Golf Club and The Millbrook Golf Club — The field will be split for the first two rounds with all players to play one round at each of the

courses.

Rounds 3 and 4 will be played at The Hills Golf Club

New Zealand Open - Pro Am

The NZ Open Pro Am field will comprise of 132 NZ Open competitors plus 132 amateur players. One NZ Open competitor and one amateur will make up one team. In the event of 132 professionals making the final field, the 4 New Zealand elite amateurs will not compete in the Pro-Am Teams Event

New Zealand Open competitors will be allocated a position in the event based on the following system:

If local non exempt elite amateur's pre qualify, thus reducing the number of pre qualifying professionals to less than 10, the team positions will be filled by selected NZ Golf exempt elite amateurs until the 132 teams are filled.

Should a greater number than 4 local amateurs pre qualify for the Championship, they will join the teams event based on their pre qualifying ranking

In the event if the Team Amateur numbers failing to reach the required 132 figure, the Tournament Committee reserve the right to reduce the number of teams in the Team Competition, utilising the above allocation structure to fill the required number of partners required.

Scoring for the NZ Open Pro Am will be best team NET score (professionals will play off scratch and the amateur will play off 75% of their course handicap)

Amateurs to compete off **WHITE TEES**

Leading 35 teams plus ties after 36 holes will qualify to play round 3 at The Hills Golf Club

Leading 10 teams plus ties after 54 holes will qualify to play the final round (round 4) at The Hills Golf Club

*All amateur players who miss the Pro-Am 36 hole cut will play a separate one day Pro Am at Jack's Point Golf Course on Saturday March 1

If a professional misses the NZ Open cut, but is still in the Pro Am team's event for round 3, he continues playing in the *Pro Am event only*. If in the case these professionals do not make the round 3 Pro-Am cut, they will receive NZD \$500 reimbursement

All professionals that make round 4 of the Pro Am team's event will receive a share of the NZ\$50,000 Pro Am prize money

Pro Am at Jack's Point Golf Course (Saturday March 1)

All amateur players who miss the Pro-Am tournament cut will play a separate one day Pro Am at Jack's Point Golf Course on Saturday March 1

10.15AM SHOTGUN START

25 professionals who miss the NZ Open cut will be required to play

*Each one of these professionals will be reimbursed NZD \$500 for the day

Final pre qualifying will take place over two course and those 10 positions will be split on a

pro rate basis

PLAYOFF HOLES: In the event of players tied for 1st position after the final round of the NZ Open

Championship, a sudden death playoff will take place on the 18th hole (continuously) or as
