TOURNAMENT FORMAT

The tournament shall be decided over 4 rounds (72 holes) stroke play. 156 players will play one round on each of the first two days, after which the leading 60 professionals plus ties for 60th place, plus any amateurs on the same score after the second round, shall qualify to play rounds 3 and 4. In the event of a tie for first place, a 'sudden death' play-off will take place on the 18th until there is a result or as otherwise determined by the tournament committee.

REGISTRATION

Registration will be at the PGA Tournament Office. Registration will be open from Monday 13th November, 9:00AM to 5:00PM and Tuesday 14th November, 7:00AM until 5:00PM. Players who fail to register by the deadline with the PGA tournament office may be removed from the tournament and replaced with the first available alternate.

TOURNAMENT OFFICE

The PGA Tour of Australasia Tournament Office will be located in the Meeting Room adjacent to the sponsors function area and across the hall from the Player's Lounge.

PRE QUALIFYING

Pre-Qualifying will take place on Monday 13th November at Liverpool GC, Long Reef GC, Glenmore Heritage Valley GC and Federal GC (ACT). There will be a minimum of 10 positions available. The number of positions available at each venue will be determined on a pro-rata basis.

PRACTICE FACILITIES AND TIMES

Players will use the Twin Creeks Golf & Country Club driving range (adjacent to the 10th tee) and short game facilities.

COURSE PRACTICE

Practice rounds are available on Monday and Tuesday. Some limited tee times may also be available on Wednesday afternoon from specified holes concurrent to the Junior Pro-Am. There will be no timesheets.

All players must be off the course by 10.45am.

Tuesday Course practice available from 1:00PM after the conclusion of the Pro-Am

Wednesday Course closed for Pro-Ams with some positions available concurrent to Junior Pro-Am

PRO-AM

There will be two Championship Pro-Ams; one on Tuesday 14th November and the other on Wednesday 15th November. These Pro-Ams will be a shotgun start at 8:00AM and 7:30AM respectively.

An 18 hole Junior Pro-Am will be conducted on Wednesday 15th November commencing at 1.00PM.
