Professionals - Stroke (54 hole tournament across 3 days)

Round 2 - reverse draw

Final Round – seeded draw (top 25 Professionals to play in the PM field)

Amateurs – Stableford (18 holes) each day. Presentations held each day.

## **PLAYOFF:**

In the event of a tie for first place, a 'hole-by-hole' play-off will be conducted to determine the title holder and prize money. If a play-off involves more than two players, those other than the winner will be deemed to have tied for second place regardless of their scores in the play-off. The play-off will be conducted over holes determined by the Tournament Committee. The play-off will be conducted in accordance with the Policy for selecting the Order of Play in Play-Offs. Should a play-off not be possible, the tournament committee may declare joint winners.
