# **TOURNAMENT FORMAT**

The tournament shall be decided over 4 rounds (72 holes) stroke play. 120 players will play one round on each of the first two days, after which the leading 50 professionals plus ties for 50<sup>th</sup> place, plus any amateurs on the same score or better after the second round, shall qualify to play rounds 3 and 4. In the event of a tie for first place, a 'sudden death' play-off will take place on the 18<sup>th</sup> until there is a result or as otherwise determined by the tournament committee.

## 2018 event

In 2018, the WA PGA Championship will again have an added element of "Road to the Outback Challenge" amateurs playing across the weekend with those players that make the cut. In the event of there being less amateurs than Championship competitors, teams will be formed using the highest ranked players that have made the cut. The teams event will be calculated on the basis of the best Stableford points score achieved on each hole by either the professional or his amateur partner to then provide a total team score for the round. The amateurs you will be playing with have pre-qualified across 4 venues in WA in an event called 'Road to the Outback'.

The Road to the Outback Challenge carries **additional non-official prize money of \$5,000** with the winning team pro taking \$2,500-, second place team pro \$1,500 and third place pro team \$1000.

## REGISTRATION

Registration will be at the PGA Tournament Office. Registration will be open from Monday 7<sup>h</sup> May, 9:00AM to 5:00PM and Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> May, 7:30AM until 5:00PM. Players who fail to register with the PGA tournament office may be removed from the tournament and replaced with the first available alternate.

## **TOURNAMENT OFFICE**

The PGA Tour of Australasia Tournament Office will be located in a demountable adjacent to the clubhouse.

#### PRE QUALIFYING

There will be no pre-qualifying for this event. Should the number of entries exceed the maximum field size; players without an exemption category will be ranked by the following criteria.

- 1. PGA of Australasia Full Tournament Members (in order of date of entry)
- 2. Full Members of the PGA of Australia (based on most recent Final National Rankings, then order of entry)
- 3. PGA Affiliate Members (in order of date of entry)
- 4. Members of other recognised Tours (in order of date of entry)
- 5. Members of other recognised PGAs (in order of date of entry)
- 6. Non-aligned professionals (in order of date of entry)
- 7. Amateurs in handicap order

The tournament Pro-Ams will take place on Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> May. There will be a 07:00AM and a 12:30PM shotgun start. All Professionals playing in the tournament Pro-Ams are REQUIRED to attend the post round function and prize giving. Functions will be conducted in as timely a manner as possible.

All Professionals playing in the tournament are encouraged to attend the "Welcome to Country" function hosted by The City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder, where light refreshments will be served. The function will include a welcome from City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder CEO and/or Mayor and an information session and will be between 5:00PM - 6.30PM, Tuesday May 8<sup>th</sup>, 2018.
