TOURNAMENT FORMAT

The tournament shall be decided over 4 rounds (72 holes) stroke play. 120 players will play one round on each of the first two days, after which the leading 50 professionals plus ties for 50th place, plus any amateurs on the same score after the second round, shall qualify to play rounds 3 and 4.

In the event of a tie for first place in the Championship, a 'sudden death' play-off will take place on the 18th hole until a result has been achieved or as otherwise determined by the tournament committee.

The Rebel Sports Masters will have an added element of amateurs playing across the weekend with those players that make the cut. In the event of there being less amateurs than Championship competitors, teams will be formed using the highest ranked players that have made the cut. The teams event will be calculated by using the best ball score of the two partners. Golf carts will be used for the play of rounds three and four.

The NZ Masters Teams Event carries **additional prize money of NZD\$20,000** with the prize breakdown being Winner - \$7,500, Second \$5,000, Third \$3,500, Fourth \$2,500 and Fifth \$1,500.

REGISTRATION

Registration will be at the PGA Tournament Office. Registration will be open from Monday 8th January, 9:00AM to 5:00PM and Tuesday 9th January, 8:00AM until 5:00PM. Players who fail to register with the PGA tournament office may be removed from the tournament and replaced with the first available alternate.

The PGA Tour of Australasia Tournament Office will be located in the Meeting Room of Wainui Golf Club.

PRE QUALIFYING

Pre-Qualifying will take place on Monday January 8 at Muriwai Golf Club. There will be a <u>minimum</u> of 10 positions available. (Undersubscribed PGATA positions from 2018 Categories and unutilized invitational positions will be returned to the official Pre-Qualifying)
