Field Size Not less than 108 exempt professionals. This amount may increase at the discretion of

the event promoter. Professional entries will be ranked using the 2018 Legends Tour

National Exemption Categories as at close of entries being 11.10.18.

FIELD SIZE

Maximum of 108 professionals – cut to 50 + ties following completion of Round 2.

- ** Cut and Prize Money for 3 and 4 Round Events
 - (i) Unless specifically noted in the Conditions of Competition, for all Tier 3, Seniors and Trainee Tournaments which have a cut, 50 Professionals plus ties will progress through to a third and/or fourth round. Prize money will be paid out as per the Legends Tour 60 position prize money split, with any unallocated prize money being reallocated to the field as per regulation 9.1.5(c) Should any Player be disqualified or withdraws after making the cut, the provisions of 9.3.9 shall apply.
- **Field Breakdown
- 104 players from 2018 Legends Tour exemption categories
- 4 players from pre qualifying
- **Pre-Qualifying

If entries exceed 108, the top 104 players from Legends Tour categories "A" to "J" will be exempt. The remaining players will attend qualifying on TBC for a minimum of 4 spots. If less than 104 players are exempt but total entries exceed 108, more pre-qualifying positions will become available

PLAY OFF

In the event of a tie for first place, a 'hole-by-hole' playoff will be conducted to determine the title holder and prize money. If a play-off involves more than two players, those other than the winner will be deemed to have tied for second place regardless of their scores in the play-off. The playoff will be conducted over holes determined by the Tournament Committee.

The play-off will be conducted in accordance with the Policy for selecting the Order of Play in Play-Offs.

REGISTRATION

Players are to register with the PGA representative no later than 5.30pm Tuesday 30th October.



CART USE

Under PGA Regulation 9.4.13(b), only players over the age of 65 or with a certified medical condition may utilize a motorized golf cart. Applications for a medical exemption to use a cart will be reviewed and ultimately determined by the PGA Tour of Australasia Doctor. Requests should be emailed to arogers@pga.org.au with a detailed description and documentation of the medical condition. Applications for medical exemptions must be received no less than 14 days prior to the tournament start date. Such timeframe may be reviewed by the Championship Committee under exceptional circumstances.
