EVENT OVERVIEW

The PGA & JNJG Junior Pro-Am is a new event on the NSW/ACT Trainee calendar for 2018. The purpose of this event is to promote participation between trainee professionals and junior golfers in a competition setting.

All Trainee Professionals entering this event are required to bring <u>one</u> junior member from the golf club at which they currently work. The Trainee and Junior will pair up on the day to compete in a single and team event. It is preferable that the Junior member is playing off a GolfLink Handicap of <u>10 or more</u> at time of registration.

When registering for this event through MyTournaments you will be prompted to nominate your Junior partner's details in the 'special requirements' section of your entry. Please include the following information:

- Junior's full name
- Date of Birth (DOB)
- Golflink #
- Email

Trainees will pay \$66.00 upon entering the event. This covers the entry fee for both the Trainee and Junior playing partner. Trainees can request to be reimbursed for this expense from the participating junior/parents of junior.
