CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Entry Fee: \$82.50 per player. (Incl. GST) Prize pool will be determined by number of entrants.

Both players to enter via MyTournaments

Field Size: Entries limited to the first 32 teams received.

Entries Close: Registrations close 5.00pm Monday, 6th May 2019.

Eligibility: All financial members including trainees. (Except Probationary, Honorary and Non-Member)

Handicaps: Calculated under the following formula from the 2018 OOM Season.

All handicaps will be issued at the discretion of the Tournament Committee. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to issue a handicap to any player that it feels falls outside the above criteria. Any player who qualifies for two handicaps under the current Handicap system will be given the lowest of the two.

Draws & Courses:

Will be conducted in regions to facilitate convenience of arranging matches in the initial stages ie. Murray River players together.

All matches to be played on neutral courses. Players on the top of each draw have the responsibility of arranging the course and organising a date to play.

A minimum of three (3) date and time options are to be provided to the opposing team within the first week of the draw becoming known. Dates must be scheduled within the allocated time period for each round.

Dates and venues which are to be mutually agreed by both teams. In the event that a round is not played by the required date, the Tournament Committee reserves the right to disqualify any party it deems responsible. In the event that a mutually agreed date cannot be agreed upon, both teams will need to make the following decision:

- One person may need to compete on their own for that match. No substitutions will be permitted.
- Both teams will be disqualified

Female competitors will play from the female Tournament tee markers against the male par in accordance with Section 9.4.14 of the current PGA Membership Regulations using the Men's Stroke Index for handicap purposes. Male competitors should play off the tees that is equal to or higher than the Female Scratch Rating. If you are unsure, please make contact with the VIC/TAS/SA Team on 03 8320 1980.
