



2019 PGA NATIONAL FUTURES CHAMPIONSHIP

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The Championship will be played over 72 holes stroke play, 18 holes on each of Tuesday October 22, Wednesday October 23, Thursday October 24 and Friday October 25. The field will be a maximum of 144 players, with a cut being made after 36 holes to the leading 50 players plus ties.
2. The first round (Tuesday 22 October) and second round (Wednesday 23 October) may be played in a Pro-Am format with amateur players joining the field during competition. Players will be advised of amateur partners at the time the draw is circulated.
3. In the event of a tie or ties for the Championship a play-off shall be conducted over such holes as the Championship Committee designates, players being eliminated hole by hole as they fail to maintain equality with the other or others until the winner is determined.
4. The Championship will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by R & A rules Ltd, and in accordance with the PGA of Australia Tournament By Laws and Rules & Regulations, and local rules as approved by the match committee. The PGA Tour of Australasia Local Rules and Conditions of competition as specified on the PGA Tour Hard Card will also be in effect.
5. The decision of the Championship Committee will be final in all matters relating to the Championship. Protests must be made to the Championship Committee not later than 15 minutes after the conclusion of the day's play, except on the final day when they must be within 5 minutes of the conclusion of play.
6. The Championship Committee reserves the right to vary any condition of this event.
7. Riding in or on any form of motorised transport during the playing of a hole is prohibited.
8. Caddies must wear attire suitable to both PGA and club standards.
9. The Ball: Rule 5-1 Note The ball the player uses must be named on the current "List of Conforming Golf Balls" issued by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews.
10. Driving Clubs. Driving clubs shall not have a characteristic time greater than 257 milliseconds when measured on a pendulum testing apparatus as approved by the R&A Rules Limited - see also Appendix II, 5a of the Rules of Golf. (A list of non conforming clubs is available at www.randa.org under rules equipment section).
11. Balls with identical markings are to be used. Throughout a stipulated round the player is limited to golf balls with identical markings, except that the ball identification numbers may differ by number only, not by colour.
12. Pace of play: Rule 6 - 7 will be enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding them. Any group with a clear hole in front of them will be considered out of position. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties.
13. The use of soft spikes in all practice, pro am and tournament rounds is a requirement of entry into this tournament.
14. All players may be required to play with amateur players during the first two rounds Tuesday 22 October and Wednesday 23 October). Allocation and requirements will be advised after close of entries.

MEDIA RIGHTS

The Tournament Committee arranges publicity before and during the Championship in the Press, by live and recorded radio and television broadcasting, by filming, and in electronic form. The Competitors assent to references to them and pictures of them in practice and play appearing and being used for commercial purposes by the PGA and authorised Tournament Committee. Also, to comply with certain contractual limitations relating to advertising on television, competitors assent that they or their caddies may not without the prior approval of the Tournament Committee display any commercial identification on clothing or equipment other than that customarily affixed to and of the normal size and in the normal position of any such clothing or equipment.

REGISTRATION

All competitors are required to register at the designated Tournament Office at Ballarat Golf Club between the hours of 2:00pm – 4:00pm on Monday 21 October.

QUALIFYING CONDITIONS-

In the event the 2019 PGA National Futures Championship is oversubscribed the following qualifying conditions will be applied:

- Only Trainee Professionals who have passed their academic requirements for the year will be eligible to enter this tournament.
- All players must have an adjusted average of 6.75 (male) 8.75 (female) or better at the close of entries in order to be eligible.

In the event qualifying conditions need to be applied, all successful applicants will be notified by email following close of entries. See below for eligibility categories:
