

## **ISPS Handa World Super 6 Perth**

### **ELIGIBILITY:**

- a) The leading 60 PGA Tour of Australasia members as notified by the PGA Tour of Australasia.
- b) The leading 60 available players from the 2019 European Tour Exemption Category list, excluding Categories 6 and 8. (NB. The top 5 European Tour Members Regulation applies from the Vic Open into this tournament).
- c) The leading 30 Asian Tour Members as notified by the Asian Tour
- d) 6 professional tournament invitations

### **Eligibility Notes:**

(i) In the event of a player being a member and **exempt through more than one of (a), (b), (c) above** at close of entries the following will apply: -

- **Australasian players and players from outside of Europe and Asia:**  
Members of the PGATA will be entered through (a) above. Dual members of the European Tour /Asian Tour will be entered through (b) above.
- **European players:**  
Members of the European Tour will be entered through (b) above. Dual members of the PGATA/Asian Tour will be entered through (a) above.
- **Asian players:**  
Members of the Asian Tour will be entered through (c) above. Dual members of the PGATA/European Tour will be entered through (a) above.

(ii) If there are less than 60 players entered through (b) above, then the remaining spots will be made available to (a)

(iii) If there are less than 30 players entered through (c) above, then the remaining spots will be made available to (a)

(iv) When a Player who is a member of multiple Tours becomes exempt he will remain allocated to the Tour under which he first became exempt, even if he subsequently becomes exempt through his "home" Tour.

### **FORMAT:**

#### **Round 1 and Round 2: Stroke Play**

- Cut after Round 2 (36 holes) to 65 professionals & ties plus any amateurs on the same score or better

#### **Round 3: Stroke Play**

- A second cut after Round 3 (54 holes) to the leading 24 players who will qualify for the 6-hole Knockout Matchplay stage of the tournament;
- If there are any ties for 24<sup>th</sup> position, a hole-by-hole playoff on the 18<sup>th</sup> hole will be conducted at the conclusion of Round 3 to determine the leading 24 players;
- All players making the first cut but missing the second-round cut will be paid official money and Race to Dubai Points in accordance with their position after 54 holes;
- \$50,000 in **Official Money** and 60 Race to Dubai Points will be allocated to the top 3 players after 54 holes. The prize money and Race to Dubai Points will be split between the players in the following amounts:

- First place:           \$25,000           30 Race to Dubai Points
- Second place:       \$15,000           18 Race to Dubai Points
- Third place:         \$10,000           12 Race to Dubai Points

If there are any ties for the positions above, the prize money and Race to Dubai Points shall be split equally according to position. For sake of clarity, the \$50,000 will be part of the total prize money for the tournament (\$1,600,000) and not in addition to.

### **6-Hole Knockout Match Play - Leading 24 Players After Round 3**

- The top eight players at the conclusion of round 3 will be automatically seeded through to the 2<sup>nd</sup> round of the Knock-out Match Play. A hole by hole play-off will be used to resolve any ties for 8<sup>th</sup> position. (If impractical to use the 18<sup>th</sup> hole, the 12<sup>th</sup> hole will be used). Any ties other than for 8<sup>th</sup> place within the top eight seeded players will be decided by card play-off (countback) as follows:
  - Best Round 3 score; then
  - Best scores on the last 9, 6, 3, 1 holes of the course in Round 3; then
  - Card match play starting at the first hole of the course based on Round 3 scores
- The remaining 16 players (those in positions 9 – 24 after round 3) will be randomly paired and will play the first round of Knockout Match Play. The eight winners from those matches will advance to play the eight seeds in the second round of Knockout Match Play;
- Knockout Match Play format continues until a final with two players. The two players that lose in the semi-finals will play off for positions three and four;
- All knockout matches will be played over six holes of Lake Karrinyup being the: 10<sup>th</sup> hole (par 4), 11<sup>th</sup> hole (par 5), 13<sup>th</sup> hole (par 4), 14<sup>th</sup> hole (par 4), 12<sup>th</sup> hole (par 3), 18<sup>th</sup> hole (par 4). (The committee reserve the right to change the holes used at any time prior to the knock out stage of the tournament).
- Any matches tied after the six holes will proceed to the 'shootout' hole where a hole-by-hole play-off will be used to determine the winner. The player with the honour will be determined by toss of a coin or similar. The shootout hole utilises the existing 18<sup>th</sup> green played from a new tee box located approx. 80-90 metres from the green on the right-hand side of the 18<sup>th</sup> fairway.

### **Prize Money & Race to Dubai Points**

The standard European Tour prize money breakdown will be used but an **event specific** Race to Dubai Points breakdown for 1940 points will be used and positions will be determined as follows:

- Final positions 1-8 and resultant prize money and Race to Dubai Points will be determined based on the results of the six-hole Knockout Match Play stage on the final day.
- There will be no playoff matches played to determine positions 5<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup>. All players finishing in positions 5<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> shall receive equal prize money and Race to Dubai Points.

- Losers of the first-round knockout matches will be ranked 17 through 24 based on their 54-hole (3 round) stroke play total with prize money and Race to Dubai Points allocated accordingly.
- Losers of the second-round knockout matches will be ranked 9 through 16 based on their 54-hole (3 rounds) stroke play total with prize money and Race to Dubai Points allocated accordingly.
- Players finishing 25<sup>th</sup> – 65<sup>th</sup> and any ties will be ranked on their 54-hole (3 round) stroke play total with prize money and Race to Dubai Points allocated accordingly.

AUS\$ 50,000 for positions 1-3 after 54 holes as detailed above.
