In the event of a tie for either or both of the 8th or 24th position, a sudden death playoff will commence at the completion of qualifying on the 18th hole.

Matchplay Rounds: Top 24 available trainees will qualify to participate in the matchplay rounds with the leading 8 players from qualifying exempt through to the second round of matchplay.

PGA Trainees not available to compete in the Matchplay must inform the PGA no later than Friday 13th September.
