- Players who fail to make the round 1 cut are deemed to have tied in 25th position.
- Players who fail to make the round 2 cut are deemed to have tied in 13th position.
- Players who fail to make the round 3 cut are deemed to have tied in 5th position.
- Positions 1 through 4 will be determined by the final hole
- Professionals eliminated in Round 1 will be required to assist with Junior/Corporate Clinics during Round 2.
- All Professionals are required to attend presentations following the completion of the tournament.

TIES & SHOOTOUT

ROUND 1

In the event of a tie for 12th position (each bracket), the ties will be settled by nearest the pin shootout which will be conducted immediately following the completion of round 1 on the dedicated shootout hole. Tiebreakers to determine who advances.

ROUND 2

In the event of a tie for 6th position (each bracket), the ties will be settled by nearest the pin shootout which will be conducted immediately following the completion of round 2 on the dedicated shootout hole. Tiebreakers to determine who advances.

ROUND 3

In the event of a tie for 2nd position (each bracket), the ties will be settled by nearest the pin shootout which will be conducted immediately following the completion of round 3 on the dedicated shootout hole.
